Le Viet Duyen, Ph.D., is Deputy Director General, Center of Information and Documentation of the Academy. He received his Ph.D. in International Relations from Diplomatic Academy of Viet Nam in 2017. Before joining the Diplomatic Academy of Vietnam, he has served as the Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Vietnam to Venezuela, concurrent to Colombia, Barbados, Grenada, St. Vincent & Grenadines from 2020–2023. He has joined the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in 1997 and as a career diplomat, he has held various portfolios in different Departments of the Ministry in bilateral, multilateral and organization management affairs, such as: Official, ASEM affairs, of the Department of Southeast Asia - South Asia - South Pacific (1997 – 1998, 2001-2002); Deputy Director, Director, then Assistant Director-General, Personnel and Organization (2006 - 2009); Deputy Director-General, ASEAN 2010 Secretariat, then ASEAN (2009 - 2012), Deputy Director-General of the Bureau of the Party and Organization (2016 – 2020). He has also served overseas as the first Consul-General of Viet Nam in Perth, Western Australia, Australia (2012-2016) and as official at the Embassy of Viet Nam in India (1998-2001) and in Bangladesh (2003-2006). He is fluent in English and can speak Spanish.
